



## VERB PATTERNS (6) - SPECIAL VERBS:

### REMEMBER, FORGET, STOP, MEAN, REGRET (B2)

Add the gerund or infinitive form of the verb in brackets.

1. The bread dough didn't rise because I had forgotten \_\_\_\_\_ the yeast. (*add*)
